The best Porto and Sherry wines in Decanter World Wine Awards



An International Trophy is the highest award at the Decanter World Wine Awards International contest. Only 0.25% of the wines entering the competition obtained this top prize. Considered to be not only the best in their category and region, the winners of the International Trophy are the best example of a certain style of wine. More than 9,000 wines from all over the world took part in the contest, but only 26 received International trophies and Sandeman won 2 of them!

The Decanter World Wine Awards International Contest took place in London, England where Sandeman won Best sweet fortified wine above £ 10 and best fortified dry wine above £10. Competing with wines from all over the world, such as the famous Sicily and Tokay ones, Sandeman's wines were voted the best in the contest.

Described by the organisers as the "summit of perfection" Sandeman 30-Year Old Tawny distinguishes itself through its flavour of dry apricot, hazel and vanilla, as well as through its honey and spices bouquet.

Sandeman Sherry Royal Esmeralda, an Amontillado, beat a 1920 Madeira Bual to win the second international trophy awarded to the brand. This wine was described as a "masterpiece" by the jury of one of the world's most important wine contests. Sandeman Sherry Royal Esmeralda stands out through the complexity of its bouquet, stinging softness, clean flavour and walnut notes that combine to make a very intense wine.

The prizes won by Sandeman reflect the investment made by the brand, which, since 1790, has been pledged to the innovation and quality of its wines. This outcome, among others, strengthens Sogrape's leading position with its port and sherry brands.
